Citywide Banks Raises Money for Food Bank of the Rockies

Denver, CO – August 30, 2007

Citywide Banks hosted its 41st Annual Golf Classic on August 28 at Inverness Golf Club in Englewood. More than \$850 was collected from mulligan ticket sales to be donated to the Food Bank of the Rockies' Kids Cafe.

Bank founder Vincent N. Schmitz started the tournament in 1966 as an opportunity for the bank to show appreciation to their customers for their loyalty and business. The Citywide Banks Golf Classic is the longest running corporate golf tournament in the Metro area.

Food Bank of the Rockies responded to the need for a meal program designed specifically for children at risk of hunger when it launched Kids Cafe. Meals are served in conjunction with existing recreation, tutoring, gang intervention, mentoring and leadership programs. Because Kids Cafe assures them a meal in a safe environment, children are able to focus, retain information and enjoy learning.
